Performance Cosmetics, Hair, Costumes and Shoes

Cosmetics should be applied at home. All colors must match the required studio cosmetics colors.

Eyes, lips and cheeks = Berry Tones (pinks, raspberry, purples, plums)

Black Mascara and eyeliner are a must for any dancer older than Princess Ballerina/Tiny Tumblers

Inter/Adv dancers <u>may</u> wear false eyelashes

Hair should be done at home. Materials to hold a bun in place must be the same color as hair. No bun covers or scrunchies. A thin hair net works great. Hide all wispy hairs by using hairspray or gel. All bangs should be away from the *face* - See Miss Mallory if you have questions about how to get bangs off of your dancers face

All performers are required to have their hair in a ballet bun in the middle of their head

Tights and Shoes: Capezio or Bloch Brand

FINALE COSTUME

Each student is required to wear their "Don't stop Believing" recital t-shirt, white socks and white sneakers along with a <u>Black</u> skirt, shorts or pants. This helps create a uniformed look for our finale number (at the end of the recital)
